



Initial Grant Application

In order to be eligible for consideration for a Grant from the Scott R. MacKenzie Foundation, you must:

- be a qualified recipient that is a tax-exempt U.S. organization with a charitable purpose stated under section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code.
- dedicated to leading-edge human genetic sequencing and research with a goal of advancing cures.
- focus on cancer, lung disease (including asthma), diabetes, and/or heart disease.

All Initial Grant Applications must be postmarked by April 30. They will be reviewed by May 31 to ensure they meet the Foundation's criteria as well as legal and regulatory compliance requirements. If you are notified that your application has been approved for further consideration, instructions will be sent to proceed with the Final Grant Application.
